**SELECTED STORIES OF STUDENTS IMPACTED BY  
THE OSGC AT  
SOUTHEASTERN OKLAHOMA STATE UNIVERSITY**

The majority of NASA Oklahoma Space Grant funding at Southeastern goes directly to undergraduates to support their education and related training experiences. Since 2002, we have made over 100 awards to students to cover tuition costs, books, travel to educational meetings, flight training costs for aviation majors, work as research interns, and tours of NASA Centers such as Johnson-Space Center, Kennedy Space Center and Ames Research Center. We also recruit SE students to participate in the annual statewide education workshops such as the "Mission to Planet Earth" for teachers (held in June) and the "Geospatial Summer Institute" (held in May).

One recent awardee was Tucker Harrison, who received tuition support from OSGC which allowed him to participate in on-campus research. He presented his work at the 2008 Oklahoma Research Day at the Capitol, and won First Prize in his division. A Native American student, he completed his degree and is now attending OSU's medical school in Tulsa.
